Basic Behaviour Code

A Model United Nations Assembly (MUNA) is, among other things, an exercise in integrated social activity. Therefore, it requires a basic code of behaviour. The essential points of the code expected by ROTARY at MUNA, both at the District and National level are:

- Participants must not leave the confines of the [various] venues at which MUNA is held without the concurrence of the MUNA Committee Chairman, the Secretary General, or the Registrar. This is to ensure that everyone remains safe and there are no future legal claims.
- You are required to be considerate of others at all times.
- Attendance at all sessions is compulsory unless prior arrangements have been made. We also expect you to be present and “on time” on the day for each session.
- All mobile ‘phones (other than those of an accompanying adult) are to be turned **OFF** inside the auditorium.
- Consumables – the country names, the stands that hold them upright, the flags, the voting paddles, the paper notes and their containers, the pencils and your name tag holders are the property of this Rotary District. They are **NOT** to be souvenired, please. They are needed for future groups attending a Model United Nations Assembly.
